Chamberlain Power Drive Security-Plus PD210D

PROS

- Inexpensive
- Decent six-year warranty on motor
- Has "rolling code" security
- Relatively easy to install

CONS

- Chain drives are noisiest
- More expensive models have longer warranties
- Just one remote control

Chamberlain Whisper Drive WD822KD

PROS

- Quiet
- Lifetime warranty on motor
- Designed for do-it-yourselfers
- Security features

CONS

- Expensive
- May need extension kit
- Not for very heavy doors

Genie H6000A-2K

PROS

- Screw-drive garage-door openers are quieter than chain-drive models
- Good warranty
- 10yrs on motor
- Two three-button remotes
- Security features

CONS

- Not as quiet as belt-drive models

Allstar 800 Newton DC

PROS

- Energy efficient
- Compatible with either belt or chain drive T or I beam rails with soft start and stop motor
- 7-foot chain drive T-Rail fully assembled and pre tensioned

CONS

- Not all parts interchangeable with all Allstar brands

Sommer

PROS

- Well known for it's traveling motor directly attached to the garage door
- Quietest on the market
- Springs never loll
- Long lasting and ideal for garages with adjoining neighbors

CONS

- The speed of opening and closing is slow.
- Tiny remote control
